## New Beginnings, Expanding Support

Project 75216 originally started as a food pantry for emergency food assistance in 2020. As our efforts and community needs have grown, we are excited to transition into a grocery location for the North Texas Food Bank. In Q4 2024, this transition will expand our reach to families who reside in the 75216 zip code and the surrounding communities in DFW, bringing more access to food and fresh produce. As the project has expanded, additional services and programs have been introduced to support the community, including access to clothing, food, emergency financial assistance, and financial empowerment services.

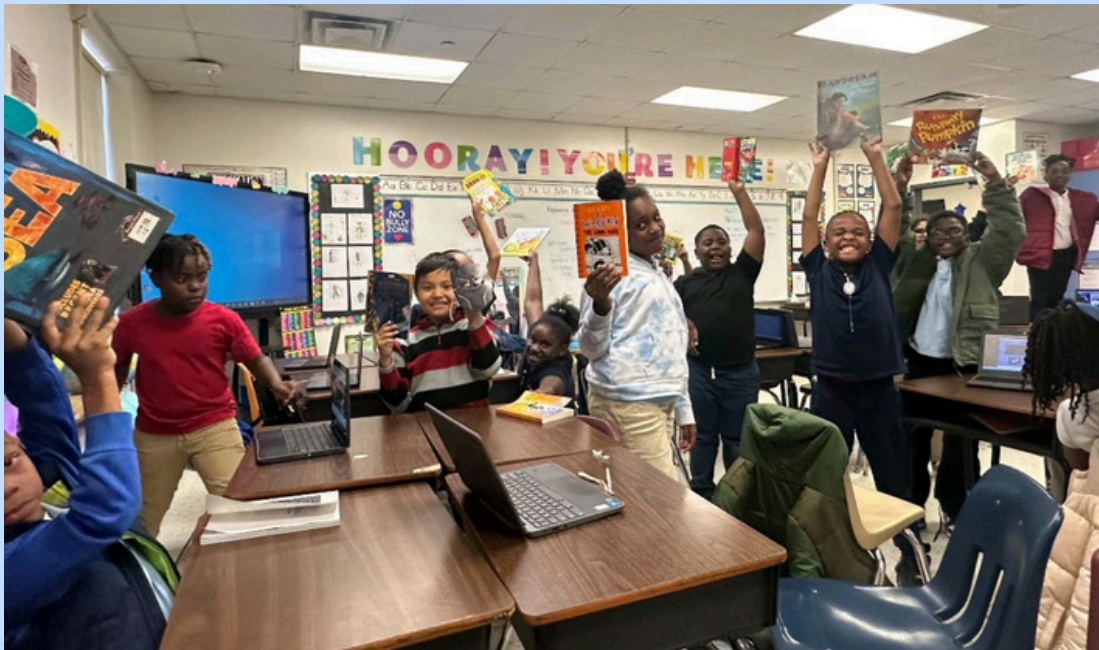


# Additional Projects and Outreach
